The heart of this ministry is teaching children to know, understand, and put into practice God's Word and to be led by the Spirit of God to fulfill the call of God on their lives. Led by Children's Pastors Adam and Tiffany Wright, and supported by a number of children's teachers and workers, I-54 Kids ensures that children are taught of the Lord and have great peace as stated in Isaiah 54:13.

Pastors Adam and Tiffany Wright, both graduates of Victory Life Bible Training Center and teachers at Bridge University Bible school, have been working in Children's Ministry for over 20 years. They started serving in children's ministry as teenagers and began preaching and teaching as young adults. Adam has led children's outreaches in the community and in Latin America seeing thousands born again and filled with the Holy Spirit speaking in other tongues. Tiffany has led and directed children's praise and worship and taught choir and dance classes for weekly services, special events, and outreaches.

Sundays and Wednesdays are our main events! Though we have fun events scheduled thorught the year, Sundays and Wednesdays are our most impactful times where we get to pour the Word of God into the hearts of kids every week!

Where can you serve?

Check-in Stations: Help parents check their children into I-54 Kids. Make sure the kids have their name tags and are checked into the system.

Pit Stop Monitor: Monitor the Pit Stop before and/or after service to ensure the kids safety/ fun. Make sure kids are sharing on the various games and no one child is monopolizing any one game.

Door Greeter: Greet the kids and parents as they come in and assist them in checking in. **Wednesday Night Teachers:** Take a specific class (i.e. 1st grade or 2nd grade) to their class and teach the curriculum lesson for the week. Included in the lesson are craft ideas, and interactive teaching.

Excite Nite Worker: Participate and help out with the planned activities.

In Service Tasks

Present Announcements: Briefly tell the kids about the upcoming I-54 events.

Teach Tithes and Offerings Lesson: Teach a short offering message, and take up the offering.

Praise & Worship Leader: Lead the children in praise and worship including using hand motions and dance moves.

Game Master: Create and/or lead a game during the service. The game can be either for the entire group, or a select number of kids.

Lead Memory Verse Game: Review the memory verse in a fun way with the kids.

Welcome Visitors: Introduce any new children to the class, asking them a couple silly/quick questions about themselves (i.e. favorite food, color, Christmas movie).

Section Monitor: Monitor the sides during the service to ensure kids are following the rules, not talking/playing during the lesson times.

Introduce Workers: Introduce workers and ask them a few questions about themselves.

Dismissal Door Monitor: Call kids as parents come to pick them up. Pass out materials as needed when they exit.

Snack Bar: Sell candy to support kids ministry. Give out free popcorn to those that have signed notes or a "FREE POPCORN" card. Give out a free item to returning visitors with post-cards or to kids with a "ONE FREE ITEM" card.

4/5 year old teachers: Take 4/5 year olds to class and conduct a service with them. Included in the service should be an illustrated lesson, game time, praise and worship, and stack time. Optional activities include, but are not limited to crafts and coloring time.

4/5 year old helper: Assist teacher in teaching the lesson, passing out materials, and monitoring students.

All of our events are designed to meet and match the vision of Christian Worship Center, which is to provide "Faith for Every Generation" through REACHing the lost, CONNECTing the Christian, and SERVing our generation in our community. - Kids still need to be monitored before going up to classes and when brought back downstairs and parents are picking up kids.
