Parents,

We are so excited about Camp I-54! It will be a great few days of worship, the word, games, and fun!

We are going to a great campground called Twin Lakes Campground in Woodworth, Louisiana. Safety is our number one priority during kids camp. Your child will be required to be with at least 3 other people at all times while at camp. Most of our days will be structured, but there is some free time each day where your child can choose the activities that they participate in. Children will be required to participate in all scheduled activities, such as the services, meals, lake/pool (they don't have to get in, but they must go with the group), and team games. During free time, the kids will be able to go to the room to relax if a leader is present.

Kids will also be required to shower at least once per day (I know this is camp, but we have to worship God together, and it's a little harder if the aroma is too strong.)

Drop off for your children will be at the camp on Wednesday, July 22, between 2-3 pm. Pick up will be Saturday, July 25, at 12 pm.

When you drop off your child, you will also be able to sign in any money that they'll need during camp (further details below) as well as any medications that they will need to take.

Optional Spending money for camp:

Spending money can be used for the snackbar and camp merchandise. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are provided by the camp. Campers are responsible for all snacks, which are only available during meals and free time. (We will hold money only if parents want us to, otherwise, your child will be responsible for keeping up with their money.) There is a limited amount of purchasable apparel. The kids will get a t-shirt from us, but there will be baseball caps available for \$20 and sweatshirts/hoodies for \$30. If you'd like your child to be able to make purchases from the snackbar, but don't want to send them with cash, you can have a tab set up in their name to spend as they need it. \$10 increments can be purchased, though snackbar items will range from \$1-\$2. These items include: candy, chips, drinks, pizza etc.

We will also receive an offering each night.

What to Pack:

- Bible & Notebook & pen/pencil
- Tote bag/drawstring bag to carry small belongings to and from the sanctuary.
- Toiletries (**Deodorant**, bath soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- At least 6 sets of clothing (2 for each day, they will need to change for the evening service after a day of play)
- Flip Flops for showers
- Water shoes/flip flops/slides for going to the pool and lake
- Sneakers for outdoor activities
- Bug Spray
- Swimsuit
- Sunscreen
- Bath towel AND Beach towels for outdoor activities
- Kids will receive a t-shirt from us upon check-in on Wednesday.
- Any medications your child is taking, along with instructions for leaders.
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Sheets and a blanket for their bunk or a sleeping bag
- Sweatshirt/light jacket for services (AC's will be on in the sanctuary)
- Money for snackbar/offering

Do Not Pack:

- Electronics (Cell phones, video games, tablets, etc.)
- Expensive items (jewelry, good shoes, etc...)
